WEDNESDAY BEGINNER & PRIMARY CLASS BALLET

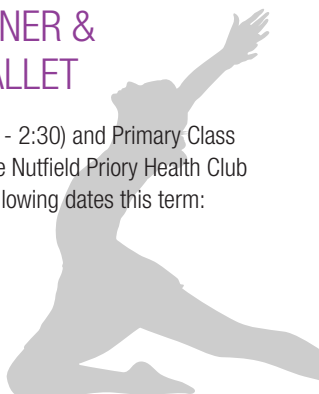

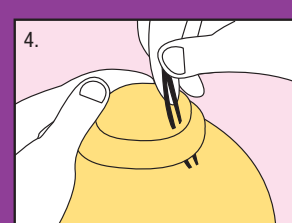
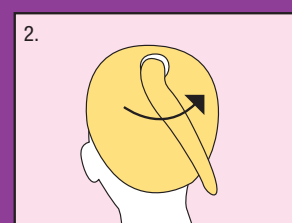

HAIR - Grooming & Presentation is an Imperative part of Dance Training.

A reminder that hair should be in classical Ballet bun please - ideally from Standard one and upwards for Ballet class.

HOW TO MAKE A BALLET BUN

1. Put hair into a ponytail and gel fringe back.
2. Twist ponytail.
3. Coil into bun shape.
4. Secure with pins.
5. Place hair net around the bun and secure with grips
